

SUNLAND-TUJUNGA POET LAUREATE APPLICATION

Due Date: January 15, 2017

REQUIREMENTS

- 1) All applicants must be at least 18 years old and active members of the local poetry community. The candidates should be residents of the Foothills, from Lake View Terrace to La Canada Flintridge, inclusive of Sunland, Tujunga, Shadow Hills, La Crescenta, and Montrose. They must show a history of participation in the local poetry community and will be expected to actively engage with the activities of Village Poets of Sunland-Tujunga.
- 2) All applicants must be able to demonstrate an engagement in poetry activities through publication and participation in poetry readings, especially as a featured poet.
- 3) The applicants must agree to serve as Poet Laureate for a term of two years, and during this period organize and participate in volunteer activities, poetry readings, publications, and other projects contributing to the promotion of poetry and the arts in the community, especially the area of Sunland-Tujunga.
- 4) The Poet-Laureate of Sunland Tujunga must commit himself/herself to attending the Passing of the Laurels Ceremony on April 23, 2017, as well as a similar ceremony at the end of the term in office, held in April 2019.
- 5) The Poet-Laureate must demonstrate engagement with the local poetry world by attending at least six of the eleven monthly readings of the Village Poets in Tujunga, CA, as well as other readings, such as Wide Open Readings at the ST Library. See: Villagepoets.blogspot.com.

POET LAUREATE DUTIES

Becoming Poet Laureate of Sunland-Tujunga is not only a great honor it is a commitment to the community. The Poet Laureate is expected to use his or her talents and means to make the community more aware of poetry.

While there are no specified duties for the Poet Laureate, the Poet Laureate of Sunland-Tujunga is expected to hold a reasonable public presence in the community.

Each Poet Laureate provides community service according to his or her special skills. In the past, Sunland-Tujunga Laureates have read poetry at community events, festivals, fairs, and public schools; they have written commemorative poems for exhibitions, meetings, and special events. They have taught poetry workshops, organized poetry readings and community festivals, as well as have given speeches and a variety of readings in California and beyond.

Each Laureate has produced at least one book during his/her term in office. The most recent books were published by Moonrise Press of Sunland, and a Poet Laureate Anthology is planned by Village Poets for 2017 or 2018, preferably edited by the newly elected Poet Laureate.

CA 91042. These events include music and poetry performances and presence of government representatives, along with the community.
